Understanding our codes



§ 21-804 Disposal of Snow and Ice.

No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any snow or ice on or immediately next to a fire hydrant or on any sidewalk, roadway or loading and unloading areas of a public transportation system, except that snow and ice may be mounded by the Borough of Oxford on public cart ways incident to the cleaning thereof or mounded on curbs incident to the clearing of sidewalks in business districts.

§ 21-802 Responsibility for Removal From Sidewalks.

1. Every person in charge or control of any building or lot of land fronting or abutting on a sidewalk, whether as owner, tenant, occupant, lessee or otherwise, shall remove and clear away or cause to be removed or cleared away snow and/or ice from a path of at least 30 inches in width from so much of said sidewalk as is in front of or abuts on said building or lot of land.

A. Snow and ice shall be removed from the sidewalks in all areas no later than 6:00 p.m. of the day following the cessation of the fall of snow, sleet or freezing rain.

B. In the event that snow or ice on the sidewalk becomes so hard that it cannot be removed without likelihood of damage to the sidewalk, the person charged with its removal shall, within the time mentioned above, cause enough sand or other abrasive to be put on the sidewalk to make travel reasonably safe, and shall, as soon thereafter as weather permits, cause to be cleared a path in said sidewalk of at least 30 inches in width.

***** A ticket can be written each day the violation occurs*****

§ 10-203 Height of Certain Vegetation.

No person, firm or corporation owning or occupying any property within the Borough of Oxford shall permit any grass or weeds or any vegetation whatsoever, not edible or planted for some useful or ornamental purpose, to grow or remain upon such premises so as to exceed a height of 10 inches, to throw off any unpleasant or noxious odors or to create or produce pollen. Any grass, weeds or other vegetation growing upon any premises in the Borough in violation of any of the provisions of § 10-202 or of this section is hereby declared to be a nuisance and detrimental to the health, safety, cleanliness and comfort of the inhabitants of the Borough.

§ 20-110 Disposal of Waste.

5. Grass clippings, leaves, brush or like vegetative matter shall not be placed or discharged on any public street, alley, sidewalk or parking lot within the Borough.

§ 20-105 Storage Practices. (Garbage/Trash)

1. Preparation of Solid Waste/Refuse.

A. All refuse/solid waste shall be suitably stored for collection.

B. Garbage shall be wrapped in paper, plastic or similar material.

C. All cans, bottles or other food containers shall be drained prior to storage for collection.

D. Rubbish shall be placed in containers or cut and baled, tied, bundled, stacked or packaged.

2. Storage of Refuse/Solid Waste.

A. It shall be unlawful to place or discard any refuse in any street, alley, stream, body of water or any other public place or upon private property, whether owned or not, unless such refuse is placed in an approved container, except that rubbish may be stored as hereinafter provided.

B. The storage of all solid waste shall be practiced so as to prevent the attraction, harborage or breeding of vectors, insects and/or rodents and to eliminate conditions harmful to public health or which create safety hazards, odors, unsightliness and public nuisances.

§ 27-130 Storage. (Vehicles/Trailers/Boats...)

C. Storage of Vehicles.

(1) Inspection and Registered Vehicles. In any zoning district, no trailer, travel trailer, motor vehicle, motorized dwelling, tent trailer, boat, boat trailer, recreational vehicle, or similar vehicle shall be stored outside in any yard area of any lot, except when owned by the owner or occupant of such lot and currently registered and bearing a current inspection sticker, except when specifically designated as a permitted use under other provisions of this Part, including but not limited to provisions with respect to junkyard or commercial sales of vehicles

(2) Inoperative or Unlicensed Vehicles. In accordance with the terms of § 302.S, Motor Vehicles, of the Oxford Borough Property Maintenance Code, as the same may be amended from time to time, no inoperative or unlicensed vehicles shall be parked outdoors on any lot except as specifically permitted by other regulations of this chapter.

§ 27-130 Storage. (Vehicles/Trailers/Boats...)

1. B. (4) For all residential dwellings, the parking spaces shall be within 100 feet of the dwelling unit they serve.

Definition of Parking Space: A reasonably level area available for the parking of one motor vehicle, consisting of a dustless, all-weather surface, and shall include either covered garage space or uncovered parking lot space.

§ 18-111 Unlawful Disposal of Waste.

It shall be unlawful for any person to place, deposit or permit to be deposited in any unsanitary manner on public or private property within the Borough or in any area under the jurisdiction of the Borough any human or animal excrement, garbage or objec-
