

ORDINANCE#876-2014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF OXFORD, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 15, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF OXFORD REGARDING PARKING FINES AND APPLICABLE HOURS FOR PARKING METERS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Oxford, Chester County, Pennsylvania, that certain provisions of Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, as amended, be amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Part 5, On-Street Metered Parking, §15-502, Applicable Days and Hours, shall be amended to read as follows:

§15-502. Applicable Days and Hours.

Parking meters shall be operated by deposit of coin in the meter as prescribed by §15-505 of this Part, and the parking times rates for specified lengths of times, as well as the maximum parking prescribed by §15-501 of this Part, shall apply at all times between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday in the parking meters zone listed in §15-501 of this Part; provided, however, that the requirement of this Part as to parking times limits and as to deposit of coins in meters shall not apply on Sundays and holidays.

SECTION 2. Part 5, On-Street Metered Parking, §15-511, Violations and Penalties, shall be amended to read as follows:

Any person who violates a provision of this Part shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$15.00. Failure to pay such fine within 10 days of its issuance shall result in a citation of an additional \$25.00, thereby requiring payment of \$40.00, plus court costs, from that point forward.

SECTION 3. Part 7, Off-Street Metered Parking, §15-703, Applicable Days and Hours, shall be amended to read as follows:

Off-street parking meters shall be operated by deposit of coin in the meter as prescribed by §15-707 of this Part, and the parking rates for specified lengths of time, as well as the maximum parking prescribed in §15-701 of this Part, shall apply at all times between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday, to the parking lots listed in §15-701; provided, however, that the requirement of this Part as to parking time limits and as to deposit of coins in meters shall not apply on Sundays and holidays.


SECTION 4. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is, for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of Borough Council that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.

SECTION 6. This amendment shall take effect and be in full force and effect 5 days from and after the date of its final passage and adoption.


