Just a reminder that vehicles may not be parked in the grass.

Borough Ordinance § 27-130 Storage. (Vehicles/Trailers/Boats...) They must be parked in a parking space.

Definition of Parking Space: A reasonably level area available for the parking of one motor vehicle, consisting of a dustless, all-weather surface, and shall include either covered garage space or uncovered parking lot space.

Spring is the perfect time to consider adding off street parking, new stone to your existing parking spaces or upgrading the area to asphalt.

Don't forget the permit.

Sidewalk Obstructions

Sidewalks must be maintained free and clear of any brush, grass or low hanging branches that impede the use of the full width of the sidewalk.

Please trim all overhanging branches to a minimum clearance height of 8 ft. The full width of the sidewalk must be clear of any vegetation. Properly edging your grass along the sidewalk will keep it from growing over.

Yard Maintenance

Grass must be maintained no taller than 6 inches within the Borough. If you will be out of town for an extended period of time or own a rental please be aware of this change and have a plan in place to maintain your lawn.

Parking Permits

Downtown Parking permits are for sale at Borough Hall for anyone who lives or works in the downtown district. These permits allow you to park in any of the 3 lots in town.

Kiosks & Meters are available for hourly parking.
